


# Virtual Jamestown

1. Go to [www.virtualjamestown.org/interactive.html](http://www.virtualjamestown.org/interactive.html)
2. Click on "John Smith's Voyages of Exploration."



- a. Click on "View John Smith Voyages Map."
- b. Click on the upside-down triangle next to Voyage and pick "Voyage 1." Watch the animation. Hold your mouse over the legend for the key. Add the various data to the map by clicking on a gray phrase such as "Major Indian Towns."


On the map to the left, draw the path of John Smith's 1<sup>st</sup> Voyage.

Add three additional pieces of data of your choosing to the map on the left.

- c. Now pick "Voyage 2" and follow the animation. Hold your mouse over the legend for the key. Add the various data to the map by clicking on a gray phrase such as "Limits of Exploration."

On the map to the right, draw the path of John Smith's 2<sup>nd</sup> Voyage

9. Return to <http://www.virtualjamestown.org/servantcontracts.html>. Go to "Public Records" located at the bottom of the page.

a. Go to "Census" and choose one of the options.
